Invitation for Submission

Publishers and/or authors are invited to send a submission of title(s) for the Rainforest of Reading 2020. Your submissions should be restricted to picture books (including but not limited to those typically for ages 3-9) and informational texts for students in Grades 2 to 6 in the Eastern Caribbean. Afro-centric themes are encouraged, and universal themes, too.

Qualifications

The book's author and/or illustrator must be Canadian citizen(s) or resident(s) of Canada. All titles must be accompanied by a submission form (available as an attachment.) Publishers should indicate the person responsible for liaison with your authors and illustrators as well as the person responsible for marketing and public relations.

About the Rainforest of Reading Festival

Authors and illustrators of the final twelve books will be invited to attend festivals in Saint Lucia, Montserrat and/or Nevis. Up to 12 titles will be selected featuring fiction and non-fiction books. You can get detailed information about the festival and watch a short film at out rainforestofreading.org.
